The New London County 4-H Camp was founded in 1947 on 24 1/2 acres in Franklin, CT.

An educational/recreational facility, the camp is open to all youth without regard to race, sex, color, national origin, or religion.

4-H Camp provides youngsters with a fun experience in group living in the outdoors. Through a wide variety of activities, campers develop a greater understanding of themselves, others, and the world around them.

Self development, environmental awareness, and a concern for health and safety are core skill sets taught each summer.

The New London County 4-H Camp is owned by the New London County 4-H Foundation, Inc. and is sponsored with the University of Connecticut Cooperative Extension System. The camp is licensed by the Connecticut Department of Health and is Accredited by the American Camping Association.

- Dismissal: All campers except Clover camp are dismissed at 6:00 P.M. on the last day of camp session (FRIDAYS). Clover Camp is dismissed at 12:00 Noon on Saturday, June 26th.
- Family and friends are encouraged to attend the closing ceremony at 5:30 PM.

## FUN ACTIVITY CHOICES

**ARCHERY**—A certified instructor teaches safety and beginner and intermediate skills with bow and arrow.

**CANOEING & FUNYAKS**—Instruction in safety and handling of canoes. Pond participation to qualified campers.

**DISC GOLF**—An exciting program that combines your Frisbee throwing abilities with 9 holes of golf!

**\*FISHING**—Cast your camp provided fishing pole, catching a great time & a few fish along the way. You take home the fishing pole and the fish stories.

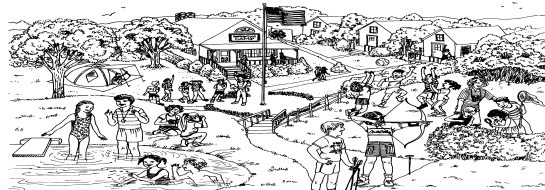
**\*ROCKETRY**—Beginner and advanced classes. Construction, safety, and **LAUNCH!** Ages 10 & up.

## Clover Camp

- June 24—26, two nights.
- Small groups for individual attention/supervision.
- Campers are housed in cabins (assigned by age).
- FEE: \$150, **no discounts apply for Clover Camp.**

- Boys and girls ages 6 to 8 (Must be 6 by 6/1/2010).
- MUST have attended a Clover session this year or last year.
- Only Session #5: July 25 — 30.
- Sign up under "General Camp".
- Campers are housed with similar age campers.
- FEE: \$399 (See application)

## Special Programs for Campers with 4-H Animal Projects

- For Campers ages 8 to 14
- Note: You don't need an animal project to participate in sessions 1 & 2
- Fee: \$379
- Note: **Session 1: Goat Projects; Session #2: Sheep Projects.**
- Learn about fitting, showmanship, feeding & care on your own 4-H goats or sheep that you bring to camp

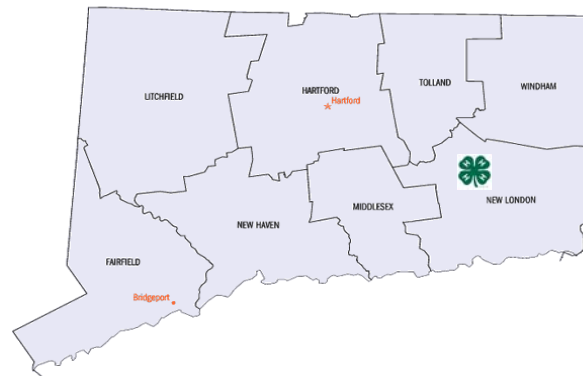
## Teen Leadership Program

- Teens ages 14 to 17 (Must be 14 by 6/1/10), selected on the basis of leadership interests and capabilities.
- Weekly from June 27—August 13.
- Receive training as future counselors/leaders.
- FEE: \$399 per week
- Special price Weeks 1 & 2 only \$379.
- Selected individuals may be invited back on a week-to-week basis at the discretion of the Camp Director. (More information available)

## Finances

- Please send deposit per session with application. *(Except Early Bird Special—must pay in full.)*
- Save \$10 by signing up for more than one child/session. Note: Multi-session discount *does not apply* to pre-season and early bird specials.
- Early Bird Special: Save \$20 by sending in application before April 1, 2010—Must pay in full. Does not apply to Clover Camp.
- Balance due by June 15, 2010, including activity fees.
- A \$25 processing fee will be charged for session change after 6/15/10 and for insufficient checks.
- There will be absolutely no refunds after June 15, 2010. Sorry, no exceptions.**
- No refunds for early dismissal due to homesickness, misconduct, or medical reasons.
- No camper will be admitted without the completed health form, signed by a licensed physician within two years of 2010 camp attendance.
